

**Friends of Twin Lakes  
Membership Meeting  
June 24, 2017**

Meeting began at 9:00 a.m. with a moment of silence to offer thoughts and prayers for the Lusin family and to thank all those who provided assistance during this tragedy.

**Board of Directors** present: Kelly Sweeney, Kurt Schweigert, Joan Weber and Judy Leaming.  
Absent: Anita Mason.

**Bob Mathes** provided an update on work done on Willis Gulch trail. The bridge is finished. Trail between Willis Gulch and Interlaken needs more work. There was a great crew last week. Next trail work day: July 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> (stay tuned).

**Minutes of FoTL meeting in May of 2017** were approved. Motion to approve by Susie Kester + second by Paula Ghais.

**Southern Lake County Fire Station proposal.** John Kester and Kurt Schweigert presented an update on a southern Lake County fire station proposal. A new set of drawings has been available since January of this year (reducing the size of the proposed fire station from 12,000 sq. ft. to 9,000 sq. ft.). Fire Chief Dan Dailey has endorsed this plan. However, we need a CAD file of the drawing which can be sent out for bid (a CAD file also carries weight with DOLA). There's a request to FoTL from the Leadville/Lake County fire department to come up with part of the costs of a CAD file (estimated cost: \$2,000).

Jeff Johnson, a CAD instructor, offered to do a CAD file for free. Discussion followed about whether to authorize FoTL funds for expenditures such as CAD software, paper, copying costs, etc. Also discussed the need for a timeline (with periodic review) and the likelihood that this will be a pre-engineered metal building. Suggestion made that John Kester + Jeff Johnson + Kurt Schweigert + Bruce Hix + Mark Glenn meet to continue the discussion.

John Kester moved that the FoTL board be authorized to spend up to \$1,000 to proceed with the CAD drawings. Second by Ahmad Ghais. Motion carried.
